

Dr. Magnus Dias-da-Silva is the co-founder and medical director of the Federal University of Sao Paulo (UNIFESP) transdisciplinary team for transgender care clinics in Brazil. He has taken care of transgender and intersex patients at the endocrinology clinics of the University Hospital. He has conducted studies that evaluate clinical care for the transgender community and translational endocrinology, focusing on gonadal development, and published papers on the disorder/differences of sex development and transgender hormone therapy efficacy on an animal model. He has contributed to the Global Education Initiative on Hormone Foundations of the World Professional Association for Transgender Health's meeting. He also directs a collaboration between the University and LGBTQIA+ community to develop and improve services for gender-diverse people.

Magnus R. Dias-da-Silva earned his medical degree at UFRN and completed his internal medicine and endocrinology residency at UNIFESP in Brazil. He completed his Ph.D. and post-doc in Developmental Biology at UCSF. He is an active member of the Endocrine Society and has collaborated on multiple Brazilian endocrinology society committees. Dias-da-Silva feels fortunate to work in transgender and intersex care and to be part of a multidisciplinary care team improving public policies for LGBTQIA+ health.
